Berkshire Young Musician of the Year 2023 Competition Terms & Conditions

- Entry fees are not refundable.
- Entrants for each category must be within the age limits of that category based upon what their age will be on 12th March 2023 (the date of the final). Please refer to the age category information on the website for full details.
- Entry to the competition is strictly regulated to String players aged 18 or under on 12th March 2023 and who can tick at least one of the following criteria:
 - A permanent resident of Berkshire
 - Attending a school within Berkshire
 - Currently receiving instrumental tuition within the county of Berkshire
- The closing date for entries is 11.59pm Sunday 11th December 2022. Late entries will only be accepted in extenuating circumstances, in consultation with the Head of Strings whose decision is final.
- The competition entries and performances in each round will be assessed by a panel of judges based on their interpretation of the performance submitted. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into over this decision. Feedback will be provided where appropriate in each round.
- Competitors may perform the same pieces in the first round and semi-final if they are successful however one piece must be different for the final of the competition.
- Competitors will have a time limit for their pieces in all rounds. You must stick within your time limit to avoid disqualification. These are below:
 - Ages 9 and under = two contrasting pieces lasting no more than 7 minutes
 - Ages 10 12 = two contrasting pieces lasting no more than 10 minutes
 - Ages 13 15 = two contrasting pieces lasting no more than 12 minutes
 - Ages 16 18 = two contrasting pieces lasting no more than 15 minutes
- The first round will be via video. Please contact us on bymadmin@berkshiremaestros.org.uk if you have any questions. You will not be penalized for playing unaccompanied and judges will take any unavoidable factors due to it being a video round into consideration.
- You will need to provide your own accompanist for the semi-final and final if you are successful, we will be able to send you a list of accompanists you can contact.
- In the event that a prize-winner is disqualified from the competition, the judges will select an alternative prize-winner and such selection will be subject to these terms and conditions.
- Official photographs of the event will be taken in line with the consent given on our online entry form. You may withdraw this consent at any future date in writing by e-mailing us at bymadmin@berkshiremaestros.org.uk.
