

GREENHAM TRUST BURSARY

In order to apply for the Greenham Trust music bursary you must meet the following criteria:

Criteria

- Your child attends a school in West Berkshire. The Greenham Trust Music Bursary will only accept new students in primary school.
- Your child is not in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- You have a gross household income of less than £3,900 pcm or £46,800 per annum

New

There is also a new West Berkshire secondary school bursary – students attending activities at The Music Lounge are eligible for the discount if they meet the same financial criteria as we use for the above.

How to Apply

Please follow all instructions including emailing us proof of earnings and arrange for the school to email us support of your application.

Proof of your earnings can be any of the following:

- Employed staff: Last three wage slips for each person in household.
- Self-Employed staff: Latest tax return for each person in household.
- Families on tax credits/income support, please provide us with your most up to date statement.

Bursary

The bursary itself contributes £70 per term towards the cost of music activities with Berkshire Music Trust (lessons/ensembles). £60 of the bursary comes from the Greenham Trust and £10 is from Berkshire Music Trust.
