

WINDSOR AND MAIDENHEAD MUSIC BURSARY

Due to a recent donation from the Price Philip Trust Fund we have been able to launch a bursary to help students in the Windsor and Maidenhead area. The bursary itself contributes £60 per term towards the cost of music activities with Berkshire Music Trust (lessons/ensembles).

 ± 50 of the bursary comes from our Windsor and Maidenhead fund and ± 10 is from Berkshire Music Trust.

In order to apply for the Windsor and Maidenhead music bursary you must meet the following criteria:

- a) Your child attends a primary school in Windsor and Maidenhead.
- b) Your child is not in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- c) You have a gross household income of less than £3,900 pcm or £46,800 per annum

- Self-Employed staff: Latest tax return for each person in household.
- Families on tax credits/income support, please provide us with your most up to date statement.
